Proc 14206 SMALL ASSEMBLY Productions

- 1. Before you leave the station, check the switch and capture events in Telvue to make sure they are set properly for your meeting.
- 2. Retrieve the "Live Assembly" keys from the "Records" drawer in the filing cabinet. Don't forget your security badge! Ask a security guard to unlock the upstairs balcony door if needed.
- 3. Unlock the door to the Live Assembly Control Room.
- 4. Turn on the Master Power Button mounted at the top of the right rack.
- 5. Wait for the Vaddio ProductionView HD System to load. Use the right hand Vaddio and associated monitors for the Small Assembly Room.
- 6. There is video tutorial on the iMac's desktop that covers camera switching operations of the Vaddio ProductionView HD. Please watch and enjoy the video as a supplement to this document.
- 7. On the Vaddio, individually select each camera on the Camera Select Bank and move the Joystick to be sure each can be controlled.
- 8. If cameras cannot be controlled, the cameras will need to be re-scanned. On the Vaddio Production View HD, using menu arrows, highlight "rescan cameras" and push the select button. The word "start" is now highlighted.
- 9. Push select to begin rescan process.
- 10. Refer to the appropriate monitors to make your adjustments.
- 11. To edit and store a preset, first adjust the position of the camera.
- 12. Then, press and hold the camera number button you wish to set on the Vaddio Camera Select Bank until it blinks.
- 13. Next, press a number (1-12) on the Vaddio Camera Presets bank.
- 14. When it stops blinking, press the camera number button again.
- 15. Ensure that the selection switch located at the top of rack C-581 is set for the Small Assembly Room. The light on the switch should be green when using the Small Assembly Room.
- 16. Turn on the Toshiba Monitor and the Panasonic DVD Recorder.
- 17. If necessary, use the Toshiba Remote Control to make sure "Input 1" [PROGRAM OUT] is selected. You may use the channel button to move between inputs.
- 18. Insert a Blank DVD into the DVD recorder.
- 19. Turn on the I-Mac Computer by pressing the button located at the rear.
- 20. Double-click the CTV user icon. Enter "ctv" as the password. Click "Login"
- 21. Open the I-Movie Application. The Import window will appear.
- 22. Click Import, choose "Create New Event" and add a title. You are now ready to import.
- 23. Always leave the Audio Level Down before the meeting, during any breaks, and at the end of the meeting.
- 24. Call CTV approx. five minutes before the meeting to remind Staff to activate the Live Bug for broadcast.
- 25. Press import in the IMovie Program on the IMac Computer.
- 26. Press Record on the DVD Recorder to begin recording the backup.

- 27. Use the Biamp audio mixer to adjust the sound for air. The Master Pot should be set at one o'clock.
- 28. As the meeting begins in the Small Assembly Room, turn the Small Assy knob up to achieve an appropriate audio level.
- 29. You will see the audio levels bumping on the Audio Meter when audio is present.
- 30. At the end of the meeting, select a wide shot of the Small Assy Room and stop recording.
- 31. Call CTV and let the staff know that the meeting is over. (215-8848)
- 32. After the meeting is over, press the Stop button in the IMovie Program on the IMac Computer.
- 33. Finalize DVD in DVD Recorder by pressing Stop on the remote control. Then press and hold the Open/Close button.
- 34. Use the Toshiba Remote Control to switch to "Input 2" to view the DVD Menu.
- 35. Follow the directions on the screen.
- 36. Turn off the Vaddio ProductionViewHD System by holding down the master power button on the upper left portion of the console.
- 37. Turn off the Master Power Button on the right rack.
- 38. Turn off the light in the control room, and lock the door.
- 39. Return keys to the records drawer at the station.
