Proc 14508_Burning DATA DVDs (iMac)

- 1. On rare occasions it may be necessary to burn a video file to a Data DVD.
- 2. It should be remembered that while such files can be viewed using the i-Movie application on a Mac computer, they might not be able to be viewed on some consumer DVD players.
- 3. To burn a video file to a Data DVD, first insert a blank DVD disc into the Mac.
- 4. Drag the file you want to burn onto the blank disc icon in Finder.
- 5. Click "Burn."
- 6. When finished, eject the disk and label it properly.
